<b>IN-PERSON</b>	Nov 6, 2018 (Primary June 19, 2018)	<p><b>If this is your first time voting in DC, you must bring ONE valid form of ID that includes your name and current address. This includes:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A government-issued photo ID (Driver's license, DMV-issued ID, US Passport)</li><li>• A utility bill (not cell phone), bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows your name and address</li></ul> <p><b>If you have voted in the District before, you do not need to provide a photo ID.*</b></p>	<p><b>Find your polling location by visiting</b> <a href="https://www.vote4dc.com/SearchElection/SearchByAddress">https://www.vote4dc.com/SearchElection/SearchByAddress</a></p> <p><b>Or by calling:</b> (202) 727-2525</p>

<b>ABSENTEE</b>	Nov 1	<p><b>You must have a pre-approved reason to receive an absentee ballot.
