In-Person Voting: Saturday, October 12, 2024	When voting in person on Election Day in Delaware, you do not need to show ID. However, providing an ID such as a driver's license, state ID card, or utility bill can speed up the process. If you are a first-time voter who did not include identification when registering, you may need to show ID to vote (Delaware Code Title 15 § 4937).
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline: October 12th, 2024	Delaware voters can request an absentee or mail-in ballot up until October 29, 2024 (7 days before Election Day). You can request your ballot through the Delaware Department of Elections website or contact your County Elections Office. All voters are eligible to vote by mail upon request.
Early Voting	Early voting in Delaware begins at least 10 days before the election and runs through the Sunday before Election Day. For the 2024 general election, early voting is expected to start around October 26, 2024, and end on November 3, 2024. More early voting options may be available depending on your county. Check with your local County Elections Office for specific early voting locations and hours.
