Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline: October 25th, 2024	You can submit your request for an absentee ballot as much as 78 days before the election. Early Voting	Georgia voters have three weeks before Election Day for early voting, including two Saturdays. Your county can also offer voting on Sunday.
