Residency or Address Requirement	Mailing address not explicitly required, but proof of residence required. Can use address of a shelter, cross street, or address of local county
ID requirement	Idaho Driver's License, Idaho Identification Card, Passport or Federal ID, Tribal ID Card, Concealed Weapons License issued by a county sheriff in Idaho

In-Person Registration Deadline	Available up to and on election day: Tuesday, November 5, 2024
Mail-in Registration Deadline	Postmarked by Friday, October 11, 2024
Online Registration Deadline	Friday, October 11, 2024

In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024	In Idaho, you do not need to show ID to vote if you are a regular voter. However, if you are voting for the first time, you may be asked to provide identification. Accepted forms of ID include a driver's license, state ID card, or a utility bill with your name and address. (Idaho Code § 34-1105).
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline: Received by October 11, 2024	Idaho voters can request an absentee ballot up to 11 days before Election Day. All registered voters can request an absentee ballot or confirm their mailing address via the Idaho Secretary of State's website or by contacting their County Clerk's Office (Find your County Clerk's Office).
Early Voting	The early voting period in Idaho begins 30 days before the election and ends on the Friday before Election Day. Some counties may offer additional early voting days, so check with your County Clerk's Office for specific dates and locations.
