| Residency or Address Requirement | Must give address where you can receive mail (ex: agency, relative, shelter, etc.) |
| ID requirement | Two forms of identification with at least one showing your current residence address are needed when you register in-person. If you register by mail, sufficient proof of identity is required by submission of your driver's license number or State identification card number. If you do not have either of those, verification by the last 4 digits of your social security number, a copy of a current and valid photo identification, or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government document that shows your name and address will be required. |

| <p>In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024</p> | <p>When you arrive to vote at the polls in Illinois, you are not generally required to show identification unless you are a first-time voter who registered by mail without providing the necessary ID. Accepted forms of ID for first-time voters include a valid driver's license, state ID card, utility bill, or government document showing your name and address.</p> |
| <p>Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline: Received by October 20, 2024</p> | <p>Illinois voters can request a mail-in ballot up to 5 days before Election Day. Any registered voter in Illinois may request a mail-in ballot without an excuse. Ballots must be postmarked by Election Day and received no later than 14 days after Election Day.</p> |
| <p>Early Voting</p> | <p>Early voting in Illinois begins 40 days before the election and ends the day before Election Day (Monday, November 4, 2024). This means early voting will start on September 25, 2024. Check with your local election authority for specific locations and hours for early voting.</p> |
