Display an expiration date and either be current or have expired sometime after the date of the last General Election 4. Be issued by the State of Indiana or the U.S. government

Mail-in Registration Deadline	Postmarked by Monday October 7, 2024
Online Registration Deadline	Monday October 7, 2024

In-Person Voting: Monday, October 7, 2024	Election Day in Indiana is Tuesday, November 5, 2024. When voting in person at the polls, Indiana law requires all voters to show a government-issued photo ID (Indiana Code § 3-11-8-25.1). Accepted forms of identification include an Indiana driver's license, state ID card, passport, or military ID. The ID must be current or have expired after November 8, 2022.
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline: Received by October 7, 2024	The deadline to request a mail-in (absentee) ballot is October 24, 2024. Indiana allows voters to vote by mail if they meet certain criteria, such as being 65 or older, having a disability, or being absent from the county on Election Day. To request a mail-in ballot, you can visit the Indiana Voter Portal or contact your County Election Board. Mail-in ballots must be received by noon on Election Day.
Early Voting	Early voting in Indiana, also known as "in-person absentee voting," begins on October 8, 2024, and ends at noon on November 4, 2024. Early voting is available at designated early voting locations across the state, including county courthouses and satellite locations. You can find early voting locations and hours on your county's election website or the Indiana Voter Portal.
