In-Person Voting: Monday, October 7, 2024	When voting in person on Election Day in Kentucky, you will need to show an acceptable form of ID. This can include a driver's license, Kentucky state ID card, military ID, or other forms of government-issued identification. First-time voters may also need to provide additional proof of identification.
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline	Kentucky voters can request a mail-in ballot if they qualify based on specific criteria, such as age, illness, or being out of the county on Election Day. The deadline to request an absentee ballot is 7 days before Election Day. Voters can check their status or request a ballot through the Kentucky State Board of Elections website or their County Clerk's Office.
Early Voting	Kentucky offers no-excuse early in-person voting during a designated period before Election Day. Early voting for the 2024 General Election is expected to begin on November 1st and continue through November 3rd, 2024. Early voting locations and times can vary by county, so it is recommended to check with your County Clerk's Office for specific information.
