| Residency or Address Requirement | Residence address is required   |
| ID requirement                   | ID OR official document with voter's name and address. A Louisiana voter must present one of the following forms of identification at the polls: a driver's license, a Louisiana special ID, or another generally recognized photo ID that contains the voter's name and signature. If a photo ID is not presented, the voter must sign an affidavit. Voters who sign affidavits may be challenged. Registered voters can bring their voter information card to the Office of Motor Vehicles to receive a free Louisiana special identification card. |

| In-Person Voting:<br>Monday, October 7, 2024 | When voting at the polls in Louisiana on Election Day, you are required to present a valid photo ID. Accepted forms of identification include a Louisiana driver's license, a Louisiana special ID card, or any other generally recognized photo ID that includes your name and signature (Louisiana R.S. 18:562(A)). If you do not have ID, you can still vote by signing a voter affidavit.   |
| Absentee or Mail-in Voting<br>Deadline       | Louisiana voters may request a mail-in ballot (absentee) up to 7 days before Election Day. To qualify for absentee voting, voters must meet specific criteria, such as being over 65, temporarily absent from the state, or have a disability that prevents in-person voting. You can request a mail-in ballot online via the Louisiana Secretary of State's website or by contacting your parish Registrar of Voters office. Mail-in ballots must be received by 4:30 p.m. on November 4, 2024, the day before Election Day. |
| Early Voting                                 | In Louisiana, early voting takes place from October 21 to October 28, 2024 (excluding Sunday). Voters can cast their ballots at their parish Registrar of Voters office or designated early voting locations. Early voting hours are typically from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.  |
