Residency or Address Requirement	Address where you can receive mail (ex: shelter, outreach center, church, friend, relative, etc.)
ID requirement	Most voter do not have to present identification on Election Day. Only first-time voters who registered by mail and did not provide a valid form of identification, voters whose identities are challenged, and voters registering or changing their address during early voting are required to present identification at the polls on Election Day in Maryland. ID can be driver's license, SSN, MVA ID, Photo ID, or utility/bank statement, etc.

Mail-in Registration Deadline	Postmarked by Tuesday October 15, 2024
Online Registration Deadline	Tuesday October 15, 2024

In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024	In Maryland, you generally do not need to show ID to vote unless you are voting for the first time and did not provide identification when you registered to vote. Accepted forms of ID include a driver's license, state ID card, utility bill, or other official documentation showing your name and address.
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline	The deadline to request a mail-in ballot in Maryland is October 29, 2024. All registered voters can request a mail-in ballot through the Maryland State Board of Elections website or by contacting their County Board of Elections. You can also check the status of your ballot or request a replacement if necessary.
Early Voting	Maryland offers early voting starting from Thursday, October 24, 2024, and ending on Thursday, October 31, 2024. Early voting centers will be available across the state. You can vote early at any designated early voting center in your county of residence.
