Residency or Address Requirement	Address OR draw location on a map where you live. Can provide a separate address where you receive mail.
ID requirement	Identification needs to show your name and the address where you are registered to vote. Examples of acceptable identification are: A driver's license A state ID card A recent utility bill A rent receipt or lease. A copy of a voter registration affidavit A letter from a school dormitory or housing office Any other printed identification which contains your name and address

In-Person Registration Deadline	Available up to and including on Election Day, 8 pm Saturday October 26, 2024
Mail-in Registration Deadline	Postmarked by Saturday October 26, 2024
Online Registration Deadline	Saturday October 26, 2024

In-Person Voting: Saturday, October 26, 2024	When voting in person in Massachusetts, you generally do not need to show ID unless it's your first time voting in a federal election, or if you are flagged as needing ID due to certain registration issues. Accepted forms of ID include a driver's license, state ID, or a utility bill. (Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 54, Section 76).
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline	Massachusetts voters can request a mail-in or absentee ballot up to 7 days before Election Day. All registered voters in Massachusetts can opt to vote by mail, and can request a mail-in ballot or update their mailing information by visiting the Secretary of the Commonwealth's website or contacting their local elections office.
Early Voting	The early voting period begins on Saturday, October 19, 2024, and runs through Friday, November 1, 2024. Additional early voting options may be available depending on local election offices, and voters can check specific early voting locations and hours through their town or city clerk's office.
