Residency or Address Requirement	Address OR short description of place of residence/where one usually sleeps
ID requirement	ID is not required of already-registered voters in Minnesota. If they have not voted in four years or more, proof of residence is required. Can present ID with name + residence, Photo ID with name and address, or can have registered voter sign an oath confirming your address.

In-Person Registration Deadline	Available up to and including on Election Day, 8 pm Tuesday November 5, 2024
Mail-in Registration Deadline	Postmarked by Tuesday October 15, 2024
Online Registration Deadline	Tuesday October 15, 2024

In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024	When you arrive to vote at the polls on Election Day in Minnesota, you do not need to show ID unless it is your first time voting in a federal election or if your registration is incomplete. First-time voters may need to provide identification if they did not provide proof of residence when they registered. Accepted forms of ID include a driver's license, state ID card, or a utility bill with your name and current address. (Minnesota Statutes § 201.061)
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline	Minnesota voters can request an absentee ballot up until the day before Election Day, November 4th, 2024. You can request a mail-in ballot or check your status by visiting the Minnesota Secretary of State's website or by contacting your County Election Office.  All absentee ballots must be received by Election Day to be counted.
Early Voting	Minnesota allows early in-person voting starting 46 days before the election, which means early voting will begin on September 20, 2024, and will end on November 4, 2024. Voters can vote in person at designated early voting locations or at their local county election office.
