Residency or Address Requirement	Need a mailing address to receive an address verificiation card - address of homeless shelter or daycare center can be used
ID requirement	A nonexpired Missouri driver or non-driver license; A nonexpired military ID, including a veteran's ID card; A nonexpired United States passport; or Another photo ID issued by the United States or the state of Missouri which is either not expired or expired after the date of the most recent general election. IF one does not have these forms of ID, they can cast a provisional ballot and (1) you return to your polling place on Election Day with a photo ID; or (2) the signature on your provisional ballot envelope is determined by your local election authority to match the signature on your voter registration record.

In-Person Voting: Wednesday, October 9, 2024	When voting in person on Election Day in Missouri, you are generally required to show a valid ID. Acceptable forms of ID include a Missouri driver's license, state-issued ID card, or a document with your name and address, such as a utility bill or bank statement. For more details, please check the Missouri Secretary of State's website or local election authorities. (Missouri Revised Statutes § 115.427)
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline  Missouri voters can request an absentee or mail-in ballot up to 6 weeks before Election Day. To request a mail-in ballot, voters must apply through their local election authority. All registered can also confirm their mailing address or request a replacement ballot via the Missouri Secret State's website or by contacting their County Election Authority. (Missouri Revised Statutes § 1)	
Early Voting	Missouri does not currently offer early in-person voting for general elections. However, absentee voting is available for those who meet specific criteria such as being out of the county on Election Day or having a disability. For more information, check with your local election authority.
