Residency or Address Requirement	In order to register you need to provide a residence address or specific geographic location from which your residence address may be determined (can list the address of a shelter, a detailed description of where you usually park your car or where you are camping) and it must be in the county/district in which you are registering.
ID requirement	Photo ID required when appeared to vote. If one doesn't present photo ID, one can present a utility bill, bank statement, paycheck or government check, notice of confirmation of voter registration, or government document. In-Person Registration Deadline	Available up to and including on Election Day, 8 pm Tuesday November 5, 2024
Mail-in Registration Deadline	Postmarked by Sunday October 6, 2024
Online Registration Deadline	N/A

<p>In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024</p>	<p>An election judge will request your identification and verify that it is an acceptable form of identification. Voters without ID may cast a provisional ballot but must provide valid identification or eligibility information either in person, by facsimile, by electronic means, or by mail postmarked no later than the day after the election at 5pm.</p>
<p>Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline</p>	<p>Applications must be received by the county election office by noon the day before the election, Monday November 4, 2024.</p>
<p>Early Voting</p>	<p>You can vote early in Montana beginning no later than 30 days before the election. The last day to vote early is noon the day before Election Day.</p>
