Residency or Address Requirement	Address OR "contact point" OR location where most time is spent. This can be a description of a street corner, park, shelter, or any other place where you usually stay. The mailing address on your registration form can be a PO box, local shelter, advocacy organization, outreach center, or the home of someone who will accept mail for you.
ID requirement	If a New Jersey voter does not provide valid identification at the time of registration, he or she must show identification at the polling place. Identification includes: Driver's license number, non-driver ID, last 4 digits of SSN, OR, Other Government ID, Valid US Passport, Store Membership Card, Rent Receipt, Valid Employee ID, Valid New Jersey Driver's License, Valid Student ID, Valid Military ID, Valid New Jersey Non-photo Driver's License, Sample Ballot mailed to you, Valid New Jersey Vehicle Registration, Utility Bill, or Bank Statement.

Mail-in Registration Deadline	Postmarked by Tuesday, October 15, 2024
Online Registration Deadline	Tuesday, October 15, 2024

HOW TO VOTE IN NEW JERSEY

Voter Assistance or Accessibility	Voters with accessibility needs can be accommodated at their local polling place or county early voting site and utilize special equipment that enables them to view the ballot on a screen or hear an audio version to help them mark and cast their ballot. A voter who requires assistance to vote at a polling location may also designate the person of their choosing to provide assistance.

In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024	Vote in person at your polling place, from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day: Tuesday, November 5, 2024.
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline	Any voter may apply for vote-by-mail by completing the Application for Vote-By-Mail Ballot (https://www.nj.gov/state/elections/vote-by-mail.shtml#applications) and returning the application to their County Clerk. It must be postmarked on or before 8:00 p.m. Election Day and be received by your county's Board of Elections on or before 6 days after Election Day.
Early Voting	Early voting locations will be open from October 26 to November 3, at least 10 am to 8 pm on Mondays through Saturdays, and from at least 10 am to 6 pm on Sundays.
