Residency or Address Requirement	Mailing address plus a description of place of residence OR denote a street corner or park, shelter as your residence. North Carolina's voter registration form includes a street diagram where applicants can indicate where they sleep. They are still encouraged to provide a mailing address when possible.
ID requirement	Voters will be asked to show photo ID when voting in North Carolina. However, all voters will be allowed to vote with or without a photo ID. If a voter cannot show photo ID when voting in person, they can still vote by provisional ballot by filling out an ID Exception Form. More info: https://www.ncsbe.gov/voting/voter-id

<p>In-Person Voting: Tuesday November 5, 2024</p>	<p>Voters must show an acceptable photo ID when they check in at their voting site during early voting or on Election Day. If the voter does not show an acceptable ID, the voter may proceed to vote by filling out an ID exception form and voting by provisional ballot OR voting by provisional ballot and presenting photo ID to their county board of elections office the second Thursday after election day.</p>
<p>Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline</p>	<p>Any North Carolina registered voter may request, receive, and vote a mail-in absentee ballot where absentee voting is permitted. The deadline to request an absentee ballot is 5:00 PM the Tuesday before Election Day. Registered voters in North Carolina must request an absentee ballot with an official NC Absentee Ballot Request Form. The form can be accessed at this link: https://www.ncsbe.gov/voting/vote-mail</p>
<p>Early Voting</p>	<p>Begins Thursday, Oct. 17, 2024. Ends 3 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 2, 2024. Individuals who are not registered to vote in a county may register at early voting sites during the early voting period.</p>
