Residency or Address Requirement	Address OR short description of place of residence. The term residence means the place in which a person is domiciled as shown by an actual fixed permanent dwelling, establishment, or any other abode to which the person returns after a period of absence.
ID requirement	You must provide your SD Driver's License Number while registering, if you do not have one, you may provide the last 4 digits of your SSN. Proof of identification is required at the polls. If you do not have a photo ID, you can sign a personal identification affidavit, and will still be allowed to vote a regular ballot.

In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024	All voters who appear at a polling place must show proof of identification. Approved forms of photo identification include: South Dakota driver's license or nondriver ID card, U.S. government photo ID (passport is acceptable), U.S. Armed Forces ID, Current student photo identification card from a South Dakota high school or South Dakota accredited institution of higher education, Tribal photo ID. If you do not have a photo ID, you can sign a personal identification affidavit, and will still be allowed to vote a regular ballot.
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline	If you are unable to attend your polling place in person on Election Day, you may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. To vote by absentee ballot, a voter must request an absentee ballot application from your County Election Official. The County Election Official will send a paper absentee ballot to the voter. The voter then completes the ballot and returns it to the County Election Official. Your application must be received by 5pm the day before election day. Your voted ballot MUST be received by your County Election Official on Election Day in enough time to deliver your ballot to your voting precinct before the polls close.
