Residency or Address Requirement	Must provide location where one can receive mail (ex: shelter). For residence, street address OR an identifiable location voter considers to be residence (a narrative description of the location of voter's residence).
ID requirement	ID is necessary to register. If you register by mail and do not have a state driver's license, state ID card, or a Social Security number, you will be required to provide another form of ID when you cast your ballot. You must present ID to vote only if you are a first-time voter.

In-Person Registration Deadline	Available up to and on election day: Tuesday, November 5, 2024
Mail-in Registration Deadline	Received by Monday, October 28, 2024
Online Registration Deadline	Monday, October 28, 2024

<p>Voter Assistance or Accessibility</p>	<p>As a voter with a disability, you can request a reasonable accommodation or assistance to vote. Accessible voting units (AVUs) are available starting 18 days before Election Day, until 8 p.m. on Election Day. If you are unable to cast a ballot due to a disability, you may designate a person of your choice, or two election officers, to enter the voting booth and record the votes as you direct.</p>

<p>In-Person Voting: N/A; returned to ballot drop box 8pm Tuesday, November 5, 2024</p>	<p>Washington is a vote-by-mail state. All counties conduct vote-by-mail elections. Your ballot must either be postmarked no later than Election Day or returned to a ballot drop box by 8 p.m. on Election Day. However, each county opens an accessible voting center prior to the general election. Each voting center is open during business hours during the voting period, which begins eighteen days before, and ends at 8:00 p.m. on the day of the general election.</p>
<p>Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline: Received by 8 p.m. November 5, 2024</p>	<p>Absentee ballots will automatically be sent to all registered voters. If you need your ballot sent somewhere other than your usual address, contact your local election official at least one month before the election so you have time to receive the ballot. Your ballot must either be postmarked no later than Election Day or returned to a ballot drop box by 8 p.m. on Election Day.</p>
<p>Early Voting</p>	<p>Early voting for the November 5, 2024 general election begins October 18th and ends November 5th.</p>
