Residency or Address Requirement	Address or map/diagram of place of residence
ID requirement	When voting at a polling place for the first time, you must show proof of identification, either with photo or not. If you do not have a photo ID, you can use a non-photo identification that includes your name and address.

Voter Assistance or Accessibility	If you need help voting due to a disability, you may bring a person of your choice to assist you in the voting process. The first time you have someone help you vote, the election officials at your polling place will ask you to complete and sign a form called a Declaration of Need of Assistance .

In-Person Voting: Tuesday, November 5, 2024	<u>Polls</u> are open on election day from 7 A.M. - 8 P.M.
Absentee or Mail-in Voting Deadline	5 p.m. Oct. 29, 2024: Your APPLICATION for a mail-in or absentee ballot must be received by your <u>county election office</u> . 8 p.m. Nov. 5, 2024: Your <u>county election office</u> must RECEIVE your completed mail ballot by this time. A postmark by 8 p.m. Nov. 5 is not sufficient.
